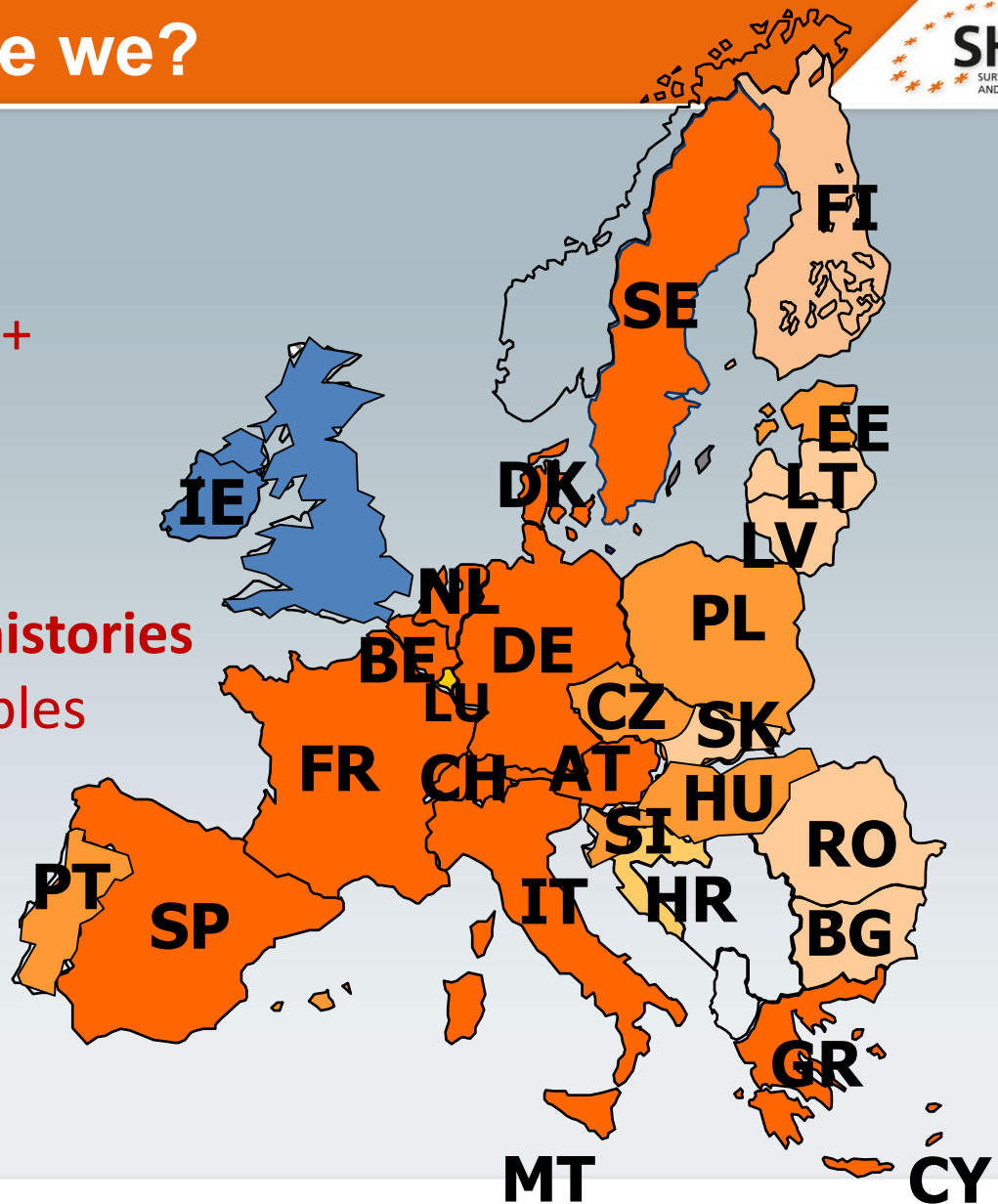

Science:

SHARE-COVID19:

- Short-term employment aid helps but increases unemployment
- Economic damage mostly through indirect effects (lockdowns)
- Family help concentrated on nuclear family

Policy recommendation to EU

Dried Blood Spots:

- Finally analyzed 23,000 DBS in Seattle and Copenhagen
- 7 conventional markers including HbA1c and fats
- 10 news markers including BDNF and ApoE4
- Solved the A1c false-spike problem with new method

Release final data in winter

SHARE HCAP

Think-Recognise-Remember: the Health Study

- 2,600 respondents in 5 countries interviewed immediately after Wave 9
- Cooperation rates: 78-86%
- Family & friends: 85%
- Strong age and education gradients across countries

HCAP II in Wave 11
