Fieldwork Agency Interviewers Completed in participants homes

Self Complete Questionnaire (SCQ) Left behind by interviewers Respondents complete in their own time

Health Assessment

Completed in our health assessment centre (or abridged version in participant's home)

TILDA has completed six sweeps of data collection








Pre-2020 plan for data collection






CAPI: computer-assisted personal interview


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Adapting to the pandemic



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
Replenishment Strategy



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Tried to use original sample frame to select replenishment sample.

- ~18,000 household addresses in the target sample.
- Respondents aged 50-62 years



Replenishment - Initial challenges



- Slow recruitment due to:
 - -Narrow age band
 - -Dated sampling frame
 - -Long duration CAPI (2+ hours average)
 - -Negative perceptions of association with 'ageing'
 - Post-Covid survey fatigue?
 - GDPR legislation

Replenishment Changes



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
- Widened age band 50-62 → 45 64
- Reduced length of interview to 90 mins duration by removing TUG and some questions.
- Deferred questions to be re-introduced at next wave.
- Updated language to reflect more positive orientation towards ageing e.g. Health + Life instead of ageing.



Replenishment progress (August 2023)

Upfront refusal from eligible adult (aged 45 to 64)	1638	15%
Non-private address	569	5%
No eligible adult at address	3540	28%
Non-productive interview with eligible adult (cancelled appointments etc)	513	6%
Not eligible due to health or language issue	207	2%
AMT or MMSE failure or consent declined	3	0%

- Response rate of eligible adults = 60.8%
- Similar to W1 RR (62%)
- Fieldwork to finish in October 2023
