FIELDWORK

 Complicated by working around the longitudinal Consumption and Activities Mail Survey in the fall

For cohorts through MBB (birthyears<1960)

- 2015 Fall non-CAMS early/partial design
- 2017 Spring CAMS full design
- 2017 Fall non-CAMS second partial or full design
- 2019 Spring CAMS sample LHMS non-response
- 2019 Fall non-CAMS sample LHMS non-response

For LBB cohort (1960-65)

- 2019 Spring CAMS sample full design
- 2019 Fall non-CAMS sample full design

No LHMS in 2021 as we did the COVID mail survey for everyone 2023 non-response followups
