 - Identification of topics for virtual follow-up sessions

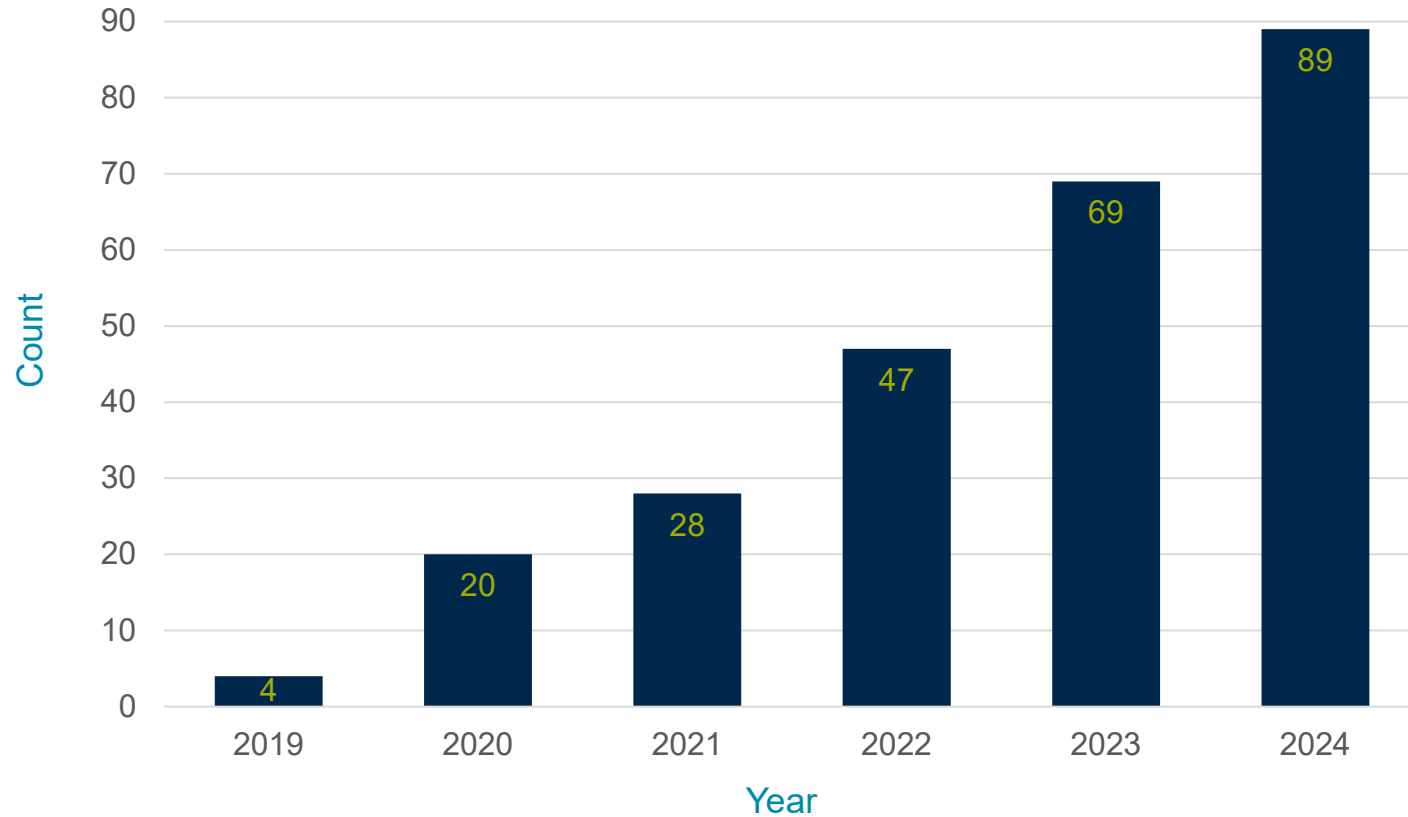
HRS-ATW Updates

HCAP U24 International Network Updates

- Continued great productivity and accomplishments across the network on data collection, publications, and plans for new studies / countries
- We supported 12 pilot studies, including HCAP pilots in Kenya, Egypt, Ghana
- AL-SEHA (Egypt) study funded with R01 (PI: Salama)
- Africa HCAP meetings in: Philadelphia (Oct '23), Johannesburg (Feb '24), and Nairobi (June '25)
- PsyMCA support in August '24

HCAP U24 International Network Renewal

- Successful renewal of funding, September 2024 through June 2029
- Kobayashi replaced Weir as MPI
- Briceño and Arce Rentería joining as collaborators on the Protocol and Administration Core
 - New initiative of this Core to develop a “Common Protocol” for HCAP studies including item selection, translation, adaptation, etc.
- Langa, Weir, Jones, Manly, Ryan, Faul, Sonnega to continue as Core Leaders
- Pilot studies, virtual “hot topic” meetings, investigator exchanges, quarterly research-in-progress seminars planned
