




#### Growth in HRS and HCAP studies around the world


# HRS studies have been conducted in over 40 countries and cover over 70% of people ages 60+ worldwide




### HCAP studies have been completed in 7 countries




### HCAP studies are in process in several countries

- Stand-alone HCAP studies may not have all HRS core variables, but we need to identify why key explanatory variables are necessary for rigorous dementia studies
- Parent HRS studies that do not have HCAP studies – we need to determine what cognitive tests should be collected
- What constitutes a minimum HCAP?
